Canadian safety course (CfSC) firearms handlingDuration of the course: 8 to 10 hours (including testing)

Cost: \$71, including a manual (268 pages), a practice test and theory examination.

This course provides the knowledge required for the safe handling of firearms. It is intended for any person aged 12 and more. The success of the full course (presence in the room and review) combined with the ICAF course is required to obtain a certificate of Hunter (category firearm). The Hunter certificate or the certificate of achievement obtained as a result of this course is required to complete a permit application for possession and firearm acquisition without restrictions (mainly the long guns for hunting). It is possible to undergo the examination directly without the course, at a cost of \$40, to later apply for a permit of weapon to fire, **but it does not allow to obtain the certificate of the Hunter**, for which it will resume the whole course (including reviews).



Introduction to hunting with firearms (ICAF)Duration of course: 7 hours

Cost: \$40, including a manual (200 pages), and the theoretical examination.

This course is intended for those wishing to obtain the certificate of Hunter in order to exercise their right to hunt with a firearm in Quebec. It allows to acquire basic knowledge of safety as well as the duties and obligations of the hunters to wildlife, the environment and other citizens. It is intended for any person aged 12 and more. Must have successfully completed this course and the CEW user course of firearm (CfSC) in order to obtain the certificate from the Quebec Hunter (category firearm).
